Checklist for Sons & Daughters of NCOA Members

- Completed application.
- Two letters of recommendation from your school, i.e. principal, counselor/vocational director, teacher of your choice.
- Autobiography in your **own handwriting**.
- A personal letter of recommendation from an adult who is not a relative.
- A certified transcript of your high school or college grades - depending on which currently attending.
- A copy of your ACT or SAT scores.
- The Non Commissioned Officers Association is a patriotic organization; therefore, the applicant is required to submit a composition on Americanism (consisting of **not less than 200 words**).
- Only those selected to receive scholarships will be notified. If you would like to receive the list of scholarship recipients, please include a self-addressed stamped envelope.
- Keep a duplicate of all documents submitted.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

1. Parent, guardian or spouse **MUST** be a member of the Non Commissioned Officers Association.
2. Any spouse who is awarded a spouse grant **must** apply for membership in one of the NCOA membership categories (i.e. Regular, Associate, Veteran, Auxiliary or Apprentice.)
3. In order to be considered for the upcoming (September to June) school year, your application must be received by **March 31**.
4. Monies granted for the scholarships will be administered by the institution so designated. If the student does not complete a full year's study, the unused portion of the monies originally grant by the NCOA Scholarship Fund will be returned to the NCOA Scholarship Fund.
5. Scholarship awards may be used to pay for room and board, tuition and library fees, text books and related instructional materials. These grants are intended to provide financial assistance for students enrolled in college-level institutions.
6. Awarding of NCOA scholarships is not limited by race, color, creed, national origin or sex.
7. Student grants are not guaranteed for renewal. Students must maintain a "B" average and carry the prescribed minimum of 15 hours to be considered for additional NCOA scholarship awards on an annual basis. To apply for a renewal of your scholarship grant, you must submit an NCOA Scholarship Renewal Application. Forward the application along with a certified transcript showing your last semester's grades to arrive at NCOA Headquarters not later than May 31 of the current school year. Parent's/guardian's/spouse's NCOA membership must be current in order to apply for scholarship renewal.
